PARTIES TO THE NAURU AGREEMENT

Nauru Agreement Concerning Cooperation in the Management of Fisheries of Common Interest (Nauru Agreement - 1982)

Established on the basis of Common Concerns/Interests

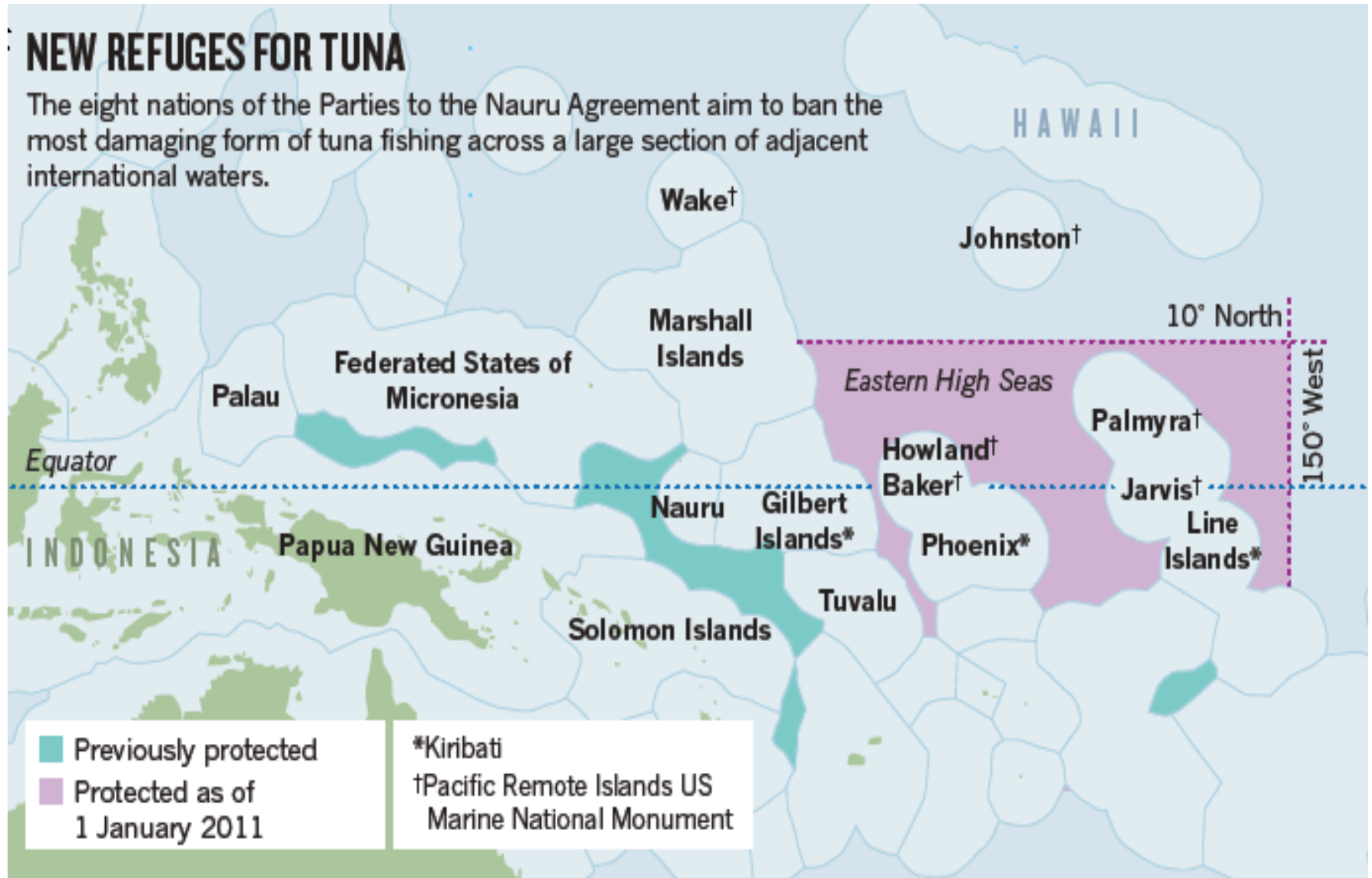
- ✓ **exploitation** of common stocks of fish, both within the EEZs and adjacent waters, **by DWFNs**
- ✓ **dependence**, as developing island states, on the rational development and utilization of the living resources within the EEZs, in particular the common stocks of fish
- ✓ **co-operation** in the management of the 8 EEZs to achieve maximum benefits from the fisheries resources

The eight nations of the Parties to the Nauru Agreement aim to ban the most damaging form of tuna fishing across a large section of adjacent international waters.
